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## Eurocontrol Selects Orthogon's Arrival Manager as AMAN for ERIS Program

**The Eurocontrol Experimental Center Brétigny has selected Orthogon's arrival manager OSYRIS for the integration in Eurocontrol's simulator system ESCAPE within the scope of the ERIS programme. The system will be used for pre-operational tests and validation at major airports.**
